Volunteer Responsibilities

- Act as a representative of Habitat for Humanity and our ReStore
- Wear appropriate clothing for attire and warehouse conditions
- ✓ Closed toed shoes are required
- ✓ Please sign up ahead of time
- ✓ If you are unable to make it to your shift, please let Mackenzie know ASAP
- √ Follow safety guidelines

General Safe Work Practices

- ✓ Practice good housekeeping at all times
- ✓ Cell phone use is strongly discouraged
- ✓ Work at a safe speed
- ✓ Learn the right way to do your job
- ✓ Follow directions of ReStore staff carefully
- Get first aid for any for any injury, even a small one.
- ✓ Never work while you are ill or fatigued
- Horseplay, running, or playing around in not permitted
- Report to work in a fit condition : no alcohol or drugs
- Report unsafe acts or conditions to your supervisor

Customer Service Excellence

- Join the ReStore staff in creating a welcoming and helpful atmosphere
- Greet customers with smiles and ask if they need assistance
- If you do not know the answer to a question, seek out a ReStore staff member
- ✓ Treat all staff, customers and fellow volunteers with care and respect
- ✓ Smile and laugh frequently!

ReStore Safety Hazards

- Lifting and moving heavy and/or large merchandise
- ✓ Tripping and obstructed walkways
- Merchandise falling from racks or not stowed properly
- Being distracted by using a cell phone or misplacing a cell phone
- ✓ Check ladders for defects before use
- Have staff train you before starting any electrical testing or repair project
- Be wary of objects falling from shelves or from the shelves falling or collapsing
- ✓ Utilize personal protective equipment as needed
